- Sanctions/Meet Schedules/Requests for Bids Several spring meets still need to be posted. Tentative schedule for Long Courses has been posted. Several additional requests for meets for 2017-2018 have been received. Notices to clubs hosting long course 2017 meets were sent mid-December and flyers, applications and fees are due January 15 (penalty will be assessed for any meets received after that date). Sanction committee will meet after January 15 and summer meets will then be posted when sanctioned.
- All Star Meet: The entire All Star application, selection, and payment process has been done on line. Eighty swimmers were chosen from an applicant pool of 140. All release forms and code of conduct forms were filed electronically using GoogleForms. All payments have been received electronically through PayPal and funds have been transferred to the MW checking account. Entries have been sent to meet host. Payments have been requested for staff and pictures have been ordered. Swimmer list is posted on the MW Team site and on the MW website. Additional information for participants will be posted on the MW Team site.
