Executive Secretary:

- Sanctions/Meet Schedules/Requests for Bids –Long Course meets have all been posted. Short Course schedule has
 been posted and meets through December have been posted in the Events on the website. The meet flyers and
 events files will be posted when all conditions of Sanction have been met. Bids for 2018-2019 have been received
 from all clubs that have previously hosted meets and schedule will be set by the Sanction Committee.
- MW Long Course Championship Lincoln Select is handling the entries for the Long Course Championship. Awards
 have been ordered. Club Billing will be sent by LSS to clubs after entries, but payments must be sent to the MW
 Office.
- Reimbursement Requests Clubs will be reminded to have their swimmers file reimbursement requests for the Long Course Sectional meet in Lincoln. Swimmers must have receipts in order to receive their reimbursement.
- Outreach Reimbursement Requests Requests are processed bi-weekly. Most clubs are getting applications to the Office within the 21 day period after the meets.
- Zone Meet: Applications for the Zone meet are being done through GoogleForms with payment through PayPal. As
 of July 4 35 swimmers have applied for the Zone team. AAA is the qualifying time for this meet. Carol is handling
 while Betty is gone. Betty will do the entries for the Zone meet in Rochester, MN. Nate Skidmore is the Head Zone
 Coach and Sean Froemming will be the team manager.
