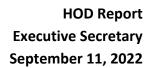

Sanctions/Meet Schedules-..

Fall/Winter 2022-2023 – A tentative Fall/Winter schedule has been published. The sanction committee is handling Fall meets as they are finalized. Most of September and October meets are posted with their event files. We are going forward with November and December meets. Meets cannot be posted until club, meet director, referee, and admin official are all current as of the first day of the meet. Meets after the first of the year will be dealt with when clubs are registered for 2023. Meets are now also put in SWIMS 3.0 by the MW Office. Eventually that will help with the OTS part of SWIMS. Process for meet sanctions for MW has not changed.

Summer 2023/Fall-Winter 2023-2024 - We have a few bids for summer 2023. We have not asked for Fall/Winter 2023-2024. Hosts are tentative about committing so far out.

MW LC Championship: All fees have been paid for the Long Course meet. The meet seems to have been a success.
 MW SC Championship 2023: The sanction committee will be working on securing a host, analyzing the past format, and perhaps looking at the time standards which have not changed since 2019.

CZ Meets:

CZ 14 & Under Meet – August 4-7, Minneapolis MN. Thirty eight swimmers participated in the CZ Championship meet in Minneapolis. Head Coach was Eric Samson and staff included Mykenzie Leehy, Paige Skidmore, Kevin Snyder, and Emma McEntarffer (manager).

- Athlete Reimbursement and Outreach Reimbursement –.
 Reimbursement requests for 2021-2022 meets total \$18,925 to date (not all showing yet in the P & L).. Outreach requests total \$1,516.32.
- MW Awards MW is planning to do annual awards in conjunction with the SO FallFest swim meet October 15 in the early evening. The office will coordinate awards for MW Top 8, MW IMX Top 3, MW Academic, Swimmer of the Year, Coach of the Year, several MW Volunteer awards and perhaps USA Top 10 and USA Scholastic All America (if we can get the information from USA Swimming).
- SWIMS 3.0 SWIMS 3.0 will make life VERY interesting for the MW Registration chair, the MW Office, and all MW clubs as we navigate online registration. Basically we are told not to hope for a complete product until maybe September 2023. Right now USA Swimming is encouraging clubs to register their NEW swimmers first before beginning to register renews and clubs. We are seeing NEWS come through for MW and some renews. Fixes are being made on a daily basis to the system. Reports that were once very easy to get from SWIMS are not available YET! Patience is the word of the day.
- USA Swimming Business Meeting USA Swimming will hold its annual business meeting September 23-24 in Colorado Springs. USA Swimming officers, committee chairs, and LSC General Chairs will be in attendance physically. The rest of the HOD will attend virtually. MW should have three coaches and one non-coach in attendance Betsy Purcell (in Co Springs), Heather Farris, Emma McEntarffer, and Paige Skidmore (virtually). Anyone can sign up and attend virtually (without a vote). Committee meetings will be held virtually before the HOD. Anyone can request to attend those meetings virtually.

USA Swimming Requirements –The 990 and Financial Review have been approved by the BOD (online vote) and both the 990 and Financial Review have been sent to USA Swimming.

Fall/September Newsletter –Will be coming out in the very near future.

USA Meetings – Betty and several others have been on Zoom meetings with other LSC office staff, CZ General Chairs and officers, and USA Swimming LSC leaders. All of these keep us up-to-date on USA Swimming issues, particularly the SWiMS 3.0 issues as it gets rolled out.

Safe Sport HOD Report 9/6/22

SWIMS 3.0 & Safe Sport Recognition Program

As we all know, USA Swimming has recently switched to SWIMS 3.0 and have made the old club portal inaccessible. USA Swimming has communicated that the ability for clubs to submit for SSRP approval will be on hold for two months, from September 1 to October 31. Clubs can continue working on the requirements for SSRP during this process but will need to wait until November 1 to submit for SSRP. Teams that have SSRP renewal dates during this time will have their status extended to January 31, 2023.

Aidan will be attending the virtual Safe Sport workshop for LSC Safe Sport Coordinators on October 15 and should have more information at that point. One advantage of the new system is that the SSRP portal will now allow club admins to view who has completed the athlete or parent trainings as part of the education requirement. This information and any updates will be communicated to club Safe Sport coordinators. As a reminder, Midwestern Swimming offers a \$200 stipend to teams who complete and are approved for the Safe Sport Recognition Program.

2023 Budget

- Budget put together based on possible income and changes to athlete and non-athlete registration process (most fees going through USA Swimming)
- Need for change in recommendation for splash fee for squad/dual/single session meet
 - Issues with single session meets may later recommend fine for going over 4 hrs/12 & U sessions; sanction committee now recommending changes to meet formats to make some lengthy meets two sessions
- Need to increase diversity support will recommend \$12,500
 - o Will look at criteria for applying for diversity clinics and multi-cultural meets
- Committee OK with minimal deficit budget (-\$1881.00)

Fee Policies

- Need to amend BOD splash fee proposal for squad/dual/single-session meets
 - o Committee recommends \$4.00 (rather than \$3.25) to begin January 1, 2023
- Will not recommend changes to BOD club fee proposal (\$250.00 annual club dues \$180 to MW)

Athlete Reimbursement Policy

- Discussion of current policy of only two MW meets per 12 month period (1 SCY and 1 LCM)
 - Most LSCs require more participation there are sufficient MW scheduled meets
 - O Recommend change to policy 4.5.2.1 (a) (3) Be entered in, swim in, and meet all financial obligations for at least one Midwestern
 (MWS) sanctioned/sponsored meet per season (both-short course AND long course seasons) three
 MIDWESTERN (MWS) sanctioned meets within the territory of MWS during the immediately
 preceding 12 months, either two (2) short course yards meets and one (1) long course meters meet
 OR one (1) short course yards meet and two (2) long course meters meets. Collegiate swimmers must
 be entered in, swim in, and meet all financial obligations for at least one Midwestern (MWS)
 sanctioned/sponsored meet during the current or previous Long Course season within the territory of
 MWS within the previous 12 months. Maximum reimbursement for any athlete between September
 1 and August 31 will be \$1200.00.
 - o Rationale: Those receiving Midwestern support need to support MW and MW meet hosts

 Also recommending addition of Central Zone Open Water Championship added to reimbursable meets at the current Sectional rate

Use of 3rd Party for Fee Collection

- Venmo 1.9% + .10/per transaction mostly for personal use; requires bank account transfers
- PayPal non-profit (charity) rate 1.99% + .49/per transaction
 - o Better fit for MW purposes? can use credit card to pay
 - o Possible use for club dues, transfers, championship meet fees ability to bill
 - o Recommend any billing to include 2.5% transaction fee
 - o Betsy will research MW's possible use of PayPal

Financial Costs

- Question of cost of financial business (HBE/Financial Review/990 prep)
 - Costs for HBE should be less with less registration work (minimal club/transfer fees plus the athlete/non-athlete rebates from USA Swimming)

BOD Items for P & P Changes

Splash fee \$3.25

P &P 8.5.5.2(b) – Intrasquad/Dual/Single Session Meets – beginning September 2022

Rationale: Single session meets would be more attractive with a lower Splash fee.

P & P 4.10.1.1 – MWS Local Club Fee - \$180.00; Total \$250.00 – for Reg Year 2023

Rationale: Cost of having USA Swimming collect and reimburse MW's \$8.00 per athlete (4%) needs to be made up somewhere in the budget. MW has not increased club dues in at least 15 years. Clubs have the possibility of \$150 rebate on the \$180 with both adult representative and athlete representative at both MW House of Delegates meetings.

4.5.2 Athlete Travel Reimbursement

The policy of MWS is to budget annually for the partial reimbursement of travel expenses incurred by eligible swimmers who participate in the Central Zone Open Water Championships, Speedo Sectional Meets, TYR Pro Meets, USA Swimming Futures Meet, USA Swimming Junior Championships, USA Swimming National Championships (pool and open water), the U.S. Open, and International and/or Olympic Trials

4.5.2.1 General Procedures

- (a) For a swimmer to be eligible for reimbursement a swimmer must:
 - (1) be registered with MWS at the time of the swim and at the time of fund distribution.
 - (2) be an active member of a MWS club or a collegiate team swimmer who is an active member of a MWS club and either a former age group member of MWS or in the second long course season as a MWS member.
 - (3) be entered in, swim in, and meet all financial obligations for at least one

 Midwestern (MWS) sanctioned/sponsored meet per season (both-short course

 AND long course seasons) three MIDWESTERN (MWS) sanctioned meets within
 the territory of MWS during the immediately preceding 12 months, either two (2)
 short course yards meets and one (1) long course meters meet OR one (1) short
 course yards meet and two (2) long course meters meets. Collegiate swimmers
 must be entered in, swim in, and meet all financial obligations for at least one
 Midwestern (MWS) sanctioned/sponsored meet during the current or previous
 Long Course season within the territory of MWS within the previous 12 months.
 Maximum reimbursement for any athlete between September 1 and August 31 will
 be \$1200.00.
 - (4) be a resident of MWS area for 12 months or moved into the area with the intent of establishing permanent residence. (Aid is not available during the 120 day unattached period, nor is aid available during the first season (SC or LC) of MWS participation.
- (b) Travel reimbursement is provided for swimmers participating in individual events.

 Travel reimbursement of one/fourth (1/4) individual reimbursement will be provided

- for swimmers who qualified for the national meet as part of a relay team and swam as part of that relay team at the national meet.
- (c) The amount of compensation received from all sources shall not exceed the swimmer's actual expenses as allowed by the USA Swimming Code. Sources include national swim committee, USA Swimming sponsors, member clubs, and business/civic organizations. These sources do not include family contributions. All compensation received or anticipated must be designated on the Midwestern financial aid application form. Failure to so designate will render the swimmer ineligible for current or future aid from MWS.
- (d) The current approved MWS Athlete Travel Reimbursement Application is included in Part 3 (Midwestern Forms) of the Redbook, posted on the MWS web site, and will be forwarded to each eligible athlete upon request made to the Executive Secretary.
- (e) Applications must be submitted on the current approved MWS Athlete Travel
 Reimbursement Application form with receipts attached and mailed (postmarked) to
 the address indicated on the form on or before *May 31* for the short course season
 and *September 30* for the long course season to be considered for reimbursement.
 Application form and receipts can also be emailed by same deadline dates to
 mwoffice@mwswim.org. Applications submitted after the deadline dates will *NOT* be
 considered for reimbursement.

Rationale: Athletes are swimming one meet per season with perhaps only one event in that meet. At this point it is possible for an athlete to receive \$1800 in support in one year with a \$13.00 investment in MW. It is unreasonable to ask MW to support an athlete when that athlete does not support Midwestern and Midwestern clubs.
